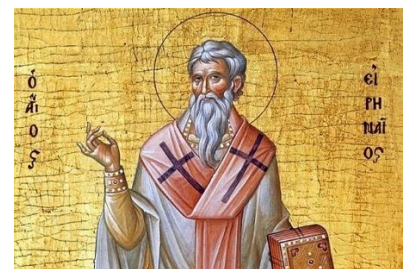
Prayer Meeting continues in the Cathedral each Tuesday evening at 7pm.

Young people between the ages of 16 to 35 are most welcome to attend.

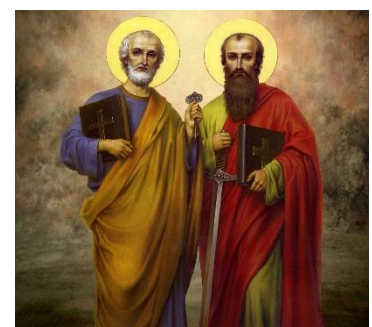
