The Presentation Brothers are very grateful to Canon John O'Donovan, the priests and people of the Family of Parishes for the opportunity to celebrate this special Mass in the Cathedral. After three years of initial and formal formation and training, a Presentation Novice makes First Profession of Vows. The Vows professed are Poverty, Chastity and Obedience.

These vows are renewed annually for a period of six years, during which the Brothers undergo further education and studies in the Presentation Brothers' mission and ministry. As he opens himself to the grace of God and deepens his generosity and love for God and neighbour, he arrives at a point where he permanently and publicly makes his Profession of Vows to God. WEEKLY ENVELOPE SYSTEM (COVENANT SCHEME)

Parish Charitable Covenant Scheme

If you've generously given €250 or more to our Family of Parishes in any one calendar year, you could make your donation work even harder by letting the Parish claim some of the tax that you've already paid to Revenue!

How it works

The taxback scheme allows our Parish to claim more than 40% in tax back on a year's donations totalling over €250, at no cost to you. All you need to do is sign up; use the envelopes provided whenever you visit one of the churches in our Family of Parishes. We will then contact you at the end of the year with a simple form to be signed and returned to the Parish Office.

Do you qualify?

If you pay any Irish tax, either PAYE or self-assessed, and you live in Ireland, then you probably do! In order to claim any tax back, you need to have donated a minimum of €250 in any one year.

It doesn't matter if you're PAYE or self-assessed for us to be able to claim back your tax paid. And please remember that self-assessed tax payers can no longer claim their own tax back on charitable donations – only the charity can make this claim from Revenue, and the money claimed will be used to fund the Family of Parishes to help make us more secure in future years.

How can I get involved?

You will probably have seen some Parishioners using envelopes at collection time. Each envelope is numbered. It is around this time of year that we order the envelopes, so if you are interested, please complete the details on the form; drop into one of the collection boxes and a member of the Family of Parishes finance committee will contact you to arrange delivery of a box of envelopes. It's as simple and as complicated as that!
