## A Mass celebrating the 250th anniversary of the South Presentation Convent founded by Nano Nagle took place at St. Finbarr's South Parish Church

The Principal Celebrant was Bishop Fintan Gavin, Bishop of the Diocese of Cork and Ross. Also in attendance was Bishop Emeritus, John Buckley; Cllr. Sean Martin, deputising for the Lord Mayor of Cork; Pat Ledwidge, chair of Nano Nagle Place and many of the religious Brothers and Sisters of the Presentation family.

Bishop Fintan recalled at the Mass that Nano Nagle was known in the city as "The Lady with the Lantern." "But the lantern she carried was more than just a light for the streets of Cork," he said. It was a light of compassion. A light of faith. A light of hope." Bishop Fintan told the congregation which was mostly made up of students of the Presentations schools in Cork that the reason Nano carried that light was very simple. "She wanted to follow Jesus and live the way Jesus taught his disciples to live."

That small light has been passed on from generation to generation for 250 years, the bishop said. "Today we give thanks for that light and for the founding of the Presentation Sisters here in Cork in 1775."
