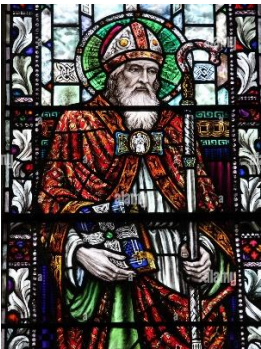
**73rd Annual Mass & Devotions for the Feast of the Assumption**

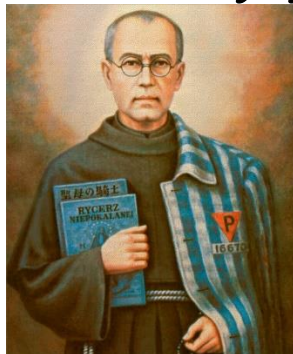
